*****Administrators Report**

Wood reviewed:

Appointment of new members and resignation of member from the Agricultural Commission.

Estimate from RounTree Ford reference the new highway truck approved at Town Meeting.

Courtesy letters sent to land owners who have open Intents to Cut as of April 1st.

Christine Greenwood/SBoW wants to know when Board wants funds available, reference Articles 4 & 5 2015 Annual Town Meeting.

Henry Underwood/SWRPC called about request from AECOM.

Call from NH DOT reference 260 Athol Road.

Received repayment from client, reference 2013 assistance.

Treasurer wanted Board to be aware the State will direct deposit any funds that are payable to the Town if the town requests (Highway Block Grant, Rooms and Meals, etc.).

*****Approve Manifest**

Daugherty moved; Jameson 2nd; the Board voted to approve the accounts payable/payroll manifest dated April 13, 2015 in the amount of \$43,723.15, for the week of 4/7-4/13/2015.

*****Selectmen**

Jameson reviewed letters written, reference the pipeline, to certain politicians; these letters will be posted on the town website. Jameson also reviewed the FERC comment letter to be posted on the FERC website.

The Board discussed posting "No Pipeline" signs on town owned property.

Jameson noted that the Town received notice of eligibility for listing on the NH State Registry of Historic Places from NH Division of Historical Resources for the Tramp House.

Jameson moved; McWhirk 2nd; the Board approved the yield tax for M408 L066.

Jameson moved; McWhirk 2nd; the Board approved the yield tax for M412 L045 & L057.

Jameson moved; McWhirk 2nd; the Board approved the veterans credit for M410 L028.

McWhirk moved; Daugherty 2nd; the Board voted to approve the gravel tax levy for M405 L121.

McWhirk moved; Daugherty 2nd; the Board approved the Notice of Intent to Excavate for M405 L121.

The Board discussed a zoning issue and potential action for a zoning violation.

Daugherty updated the Board on the road research he has been doing. This is in reference to a report due to the state by end of May.
