Daniels moved; Daugherty 2nd; the Board voted to approve the manifest dated April 23, 2018, for the week of April 13-April 19, 2018, in the amount of \$ 86,692.49 for accounts payable/payroll. This amount includes payment to Town of Richmond-Tax Collector in the amount of \$76,075.93 for 2017 property tax payments that went into lien status.

The Board reviewed the materials sent by New Hampshire Retirement System for town participation in the system with regard to hiring a permanent full-time police officer, Cameron Prior. The Board of Selectmen elected to participate prospectively in the New Hampshire Retirement System's tax shelter program under the provisions of RSA 100-A:16, I € and Internal Revenue Code Section 414 (h). The Board approved signing the Employers Acknowledgement of Post-Tax Contribution Treatment the Group II Position Certification form and the Certificate of Election which will also be signed by the Town Treasurer.

Public Appointments

Monadnock Funding Committee met with the Board. It is a Committee formed by citizens and taxpayers to study apportionment of the MRSD operational and capital costs among the towns. The committee is looking to find a long-term, equitable solution for educational funding that all the towns can support. They are seeking participation from all the towns.

Daugherty moved; Jameson 2nd; the Board voted to enter Non Public under RSA 91-A:3, II(c) *Matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, **other than a member of this board**, unless such person requests an open meeting. This exemption shall extend to include any application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver of a fee, fine or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant.* Roll Call: Daugherty (Y), Jameson (Y), and Daniels (Y). Non Public session was entered at 6:41 pm.

Daugherty moved; Daniels 2nd; the Board voted to reconvene Public session. Roll call: Daugherty (Y), Jameson (Y), and Daniels(Y). Public session was reconvened at 6:55 pm.

Daugherty moved; Jameson 2nd ; the Board voted to SEAL the minutes. Roll call: Daugherty (Y), Jameson (Y), and Daniels(Y). Minutes have been sealed.
