*****Administrators Report**

Wood advised the Board that due to the passing of SB 38 the town of Richmond could receive unanticipated revenue from the State of NH for new highway projects that were not included in the 2017 budget. The amount earmarked for Richmond is \$48,366.95. A public hearing must be held in accordance with RSA 31:95-b. These funds are additional to the Highway Block Grant and are non-lapsing and may be carried over to the following fiscal year and expended for highway construction, reconstruction or maintenance purposes.

Wood advised that the ZCO has requested an ID or badge to be used as identification when reviewing building permit applications at the applicants land.
