Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

Selectmen in attendance: Sandra Gillis, Carol Jameson and Kathryn McWhirk.

Meeting:

Mail opened and reviewed.

Wood advised the Board on the number of abatement applications received for tax year 2014. Five applications were received, 2 have been approved, 1 has been recommended to be denied, and 2 remain open. The due date for the application to be received was March 2. The Town has until July 1 to approve or deny.

McWhirk moved; Gillis 2nd; the Board voted to approve the payroll/accounts payable manifest dated March 9, 2015, for the period 3/3/15-3/9/15, in the amount of \$6,599.08.

Jameson moved; McWhirk 2nd; the Board voted to deny the abatement application for M412 L001.

The Board reviewed status of grant applications, Rooster articles, employee evaluations and pending projects in preparation for new Selectman next week.

Jameson discussed the letter to State representatives asking for support of the restoration of the Tramp House. The Board reviewed the letter and are supportive in sending it.

The Board discussed the proposed pipeline and discussed scheduling meetings in the future. Currently the Board is waiting for direction from the Town, which will happen March 14 through the petition warrant article.

Gillis moved; McWhirk 2nd; the Board voted to go into Non-Public per RSA91-A:3II(c) - Matters that, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, other than a member of the body itself, unless such person requests an open meeting. This exemption shall extend to any application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver of a fee, fine or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant. Roll call: Gillis Yes, Jameson Yes, McWhirk Yes. Non-Public was entered at 8:00pm. Gillis moved; McWhirk 2nd; the Board voted to close the Non-Public session. Roll Call: Gillis Yes, Jameson Yes, McWhirk Yes. Non-Public session ended at 8:10pm. The minutes are sealed.

Appointments:

Brendan Bosquet/Police Chief met with the Board, reference monthly reports. Chief Bosquet updated the Board on activities within the department.

Steve Boscarino/Tax Collector met with the Board, reference tax abatement refunds due to abatements that need to be signed. Gillis moved; Jameson 2nd; the Board signed necessary paperwork for the tax abatement refunds for M201 L011 and M405 L043.
