Date set for end of the summer beach party will be August 21st from 12:00 to 2:00. Blair suggested to submit all dates of events to Rooster so they will be posted in multiple issues.

residents didn't know we had a beach, we will be looking into two signs(one for each side) for the beach to put on the Pond Woods Road sign.

- Allen Lot meeting—We came to a decessicon as a Commission to fix Amidon Park before we start work on the Allen Lot. For Amidon Park we will need to fix the sink holes in the field, for now have them marked out for saftey reasons. When we are ready to proceed with the Allen Lot, we would like to start with the picnic area that would consist of 6-8 tables and 2-3 grills. A parking area would accommodate approximately 50 cars-that does not mean there will be 50 parking spaces. The space would be a plus for trailers that may contain atvs, snowmobiles or horses to safely park, etc.
