**\*\*\*Administrators Report**

Wood updated the Board on:

Conversation with Lucas Meyer, Public Affairs/Kinder Morgan Inc. Meyer was following up on certified letter sent to Conservation Commission reference input from them on the proposed pipeline. To date Kinder Morgan has not received anything from the Richmond Conservation Commission about the proposed pipeline. In addition, Meyer stated that the Kinder Morgan project team has been working with John MacDonald with the Scott Mnt. re-route. Meyer stated that nothing official has been decided yet he believes "positive" developments/changes in relation to the Stone Mnt. re-route.

**\*\*\*Approve Manifest**

McWhirk moved; Daugherty 2<sup>nd</sup>; the Board voted to approve the accounts payable/payroll manifest dated Sept. 28, 2015 for the period 9/22-9/28/15 in the amount of \$11,671.29.

**\*\*\*Selectmen**

The Board reviewed the Scoping session scheduled for 6pm on Sept. 29. Meeting to take place at Franklin Pierce University. Jameson will be attending and making comments on behalf of the Town.

The Board reviewed map of Town Roads submitted by Richard Drew. The Board thanks Drew for his efforts.

Jameson moved; Daugherty 2<sup>nd</sup>; the Board approved the building permit application for M405 L120. The permit was reviewed and approved by the ZCO.

Jameson moved; McWhirk 2<sup>nd</sup>; (Selectman Daugherty recused himself); the Board voted to approve the driveway permit for M407 L007.

The Board reviewed the Sensitive Resource Inventory, submitted by SWRPC, related to the NED Pipeline proposal. Board to review to be sure all revisions and additions were added as requested.

Memo from Fire Chief, reference complaint on member – reviewed.

Letter from Governor Haasan, reference memo from the Governor's office saying they would review the re-route proposal from Kinder Morgan.

Letter requesting use of land for Town turnaround on resident's property – reviewed and signed.

McWhirk moved; Jameson 2<sup>nd</sup>; the Board moved to approve the Intent to Cut for M405 L027-030 & 033, M402 L003, 004, M403 L026, M404 L033 036 039 047 & 048.

Jameson moved; McWhirk 2<sup>nd</sup>; the Board approved the Yield Tax levy for M411 L020.

Jameson moved; McWhirk 2<sup>nd</sup>; the Board approved the supplemental Intent to Cut for M411 L020.

The Board reviewed status of Capital Improvement projects: fire house parking lot upgraded, town hall roof contract sent to W. Rindge Builders, Contract sent to Wright Painting for the painting of the Town hall and Vets Hall, lot to be cleaned up at "little red house" so that the Town may put it up for sale.

## **Public Appointments**

**Ben Tilton** met with the Board, reference update on House Bill activities in Concord.

**Ed Atkins/Fire Chief** met with the Board, reference introducing Chad Butler as the new Rescue Captain.

**Sandy Holbrook (via phone call)** wanted to express her concern on the safety of the NH Rte. 119 & NH Rte. 32 intersection after the motor vehicle accident that occurred on Saturday, 9/26/15. She would like to suggest a four way stop at that intersection. Holbrook would like the Board to petition the State to review that intersection. Board will discuss with SWRPC for ideas.

**Steve Boscarino/Tax Collector** met with the Board, reference issues with the tax office computer and the “window” into the tax office.

**Marcus Beauregard/Health Officer** met with the Board, reference health complaints. At one, resident stated they are scheduled to have the trash removed this week. Beauregard to re-inspect the household on 10/7/15. The other the resident has taken care of the septic issue.

Beauregard also stated that his property was surveyed by Kinder Morgan on Saturday without his permission inspite of the fact that he filed with FERC that he did not grant permission and also discussed it last week with the Kinder Morgan representative Martha Hudzinski. Jameson to bring this up at the scoping meeting.

**Robert Coy** met with the Board, reference zoning violation. Coy gave an update on the improvements to date. The Board thanked him for his efforts, but would like to stress that improvement needs to continue. Coy stated the work would not be complete until spring 2016. Jameson stated significant improvement is what the Board is looking for.
