Meeting opened at 5:30 pm

Daniels moved; Wallace 2nd; the Board voted to approve the manifest dated May 18, 2020 for payroll/accounts payable in the amount of \$134,428.33 for the week of, May 8, 2020-May14, 2020. This amount includes the monthly stipend payroll and the monthly payment to Monadnock Regional School District in the amount of \$ 118,000.00.

Bersaw moved; Daniels 2nd; Board voted to approve Petition and Pole License for #31-1202. License petition is from Consolidated Communications and Eversource for Activity Road.

April 2020 Groundwater Data Transmittal for former Four Corner Stores Store received from New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services. Reviewed.

Cheshire County Sheriff's log of April 2020 received. Reviewed.

Letter from Senator Jeanne Dietsch stating New Hampshire has announced that \$40 million of federal CARES Act funds are available for municipal and county grants to defray the incurred costs of COVID-19. Senator Dietsch states that Richmond has been allocated \$27,700 and Cheshire County has been allocated \$459,426(calculations based on population). Read.
