### June 8, 2020 Meeting

**Meeting opened at 5:30 pm**

Bersaw moved; Daniels 2<sup>nd</sup>; the Board voted to approve the manifest dated June 8, 2020 for payroll/accounts payable in the amount of \$3,435.91 for the week of May 29, 2020-June 4, 2020.

Building permit received for Map 407 Lot 079. Daniels moved; Wallace 2<sup>nd</sup>; Board approved building permit.

Wallace moved; Bersaw 2<sup>nd</sup>. Board approved driveway permit received for Map 414 Lot 001.

Daniels moved; Wallace 2<sup>nd</sup>; Board signed tax warrant for 2020 part 1. Taxes are due July 15, 2020.

Bersaw moved; Daniels 2<sup>nd</sup>; Board signed Zoning Violation letter for Map 409 Lot 029.

### Appointments

**Road Agent, Buddy Blood** met with the Board to discuss the bridge on Scott Mountain Road. Buddy will reinspect and supply the Board with pricing of lumber and supplies to fix the bridge.

**Fire Chief, Ed Atkins met with the Board** to discuss the reopening of Camp Wyaka. Chief Atkins and Emergency Management Director, John Janicki are in favor of the camp opening as long as they follow the guidelines in the Stay at Home Order 2.0, the Athol YMCA guidelines they have created, and the Town has requested that every staff member and camper need to have their temperature taken daily. A log must be kept recording the individual and their temperature. Any symptoms or a temperature of 100.1 or higher must be reported to the Fire Chief Ed Atkins or the Richmond Emergency Services as soon as possible. Selectmen issued letter to Jennifer Gordon of the Athol YMCA.
