June 24, 2019 Meeting

Selectmen present: William Daniels, Douglas Bersaw and Andrew Wallace

Meeting opened at 5:30 pm

Wallace moved; Daniels 2nd; the Board voted to approve the manifest dated June 24, 2019 for payroll/accounts payable in the amount of \$170,305.98 for the week of June 14, 2019-June 20, 2019. This amount also includes the monthly stipend payroll for June and a payment in the amount of \$160,192.00 to Monadnock Regional School District.

Daniels moved; Bersaw 2nd; the Board voted to approve the appointment of Andrew Wallace and Susan Harrington to the Joint Loss Safety Committee. Terms to expire in March of 2022.

Bersaw moved; Wallace 2nd; Board voted to approve the Intent to Cut for Map 405 Lot 118.

Wallace moved; Daniels 2nd; Board voted to approve the Solar Energy Systems Exemption for Map 409 Lot 003 per Avitar Associates of New England, Inc.'s recommendation.

Wallace moved; Bersaw 2nd Board voted to approve the Property Tax Supplement Warrant for Map 407 Lot 045 in the amount of \$1,667.00.

Letter received from the Fitzwilliam Board of Selectmen inviting the Richmond Board of Selectmen or a representative from our Richmond Fire Department to meet with them to discuss a collaborative effort among towns who find difficulty maintaining enough personnel to handle the volume of calls they receive. E. Atkins stopped in and discussed meeting with the Fitzwilliam Board of Selectmen with a Richmond Selectman. E. Atkins will follow up.

Harrington advised Board of the receipt of sealed bids.

Selectmen signed Transfer of Ownership of police ballistic vests to Lt. Andrew Wood and Officer Cameron Prior. A Transfer of Ownership was also issued to transfer Lt. Andrew Wood's service weapon from the Town of Richmond to Lt. Andrew Wood.

Board spoke with Annette Tokunaga as a follow up from the June 17, 2019 meeting.
