Meeting opened at 5:30 pm

Wallace moved; Bersaw 2nd; the Board voted to approve the manifest dated July 20, 2020 for payroll/accounts payable in the amount of \$ 9,413.51 for the week of July 10, 2020-July 16, 2020.

Bersaw moved; Wallace 2nd; Board voted to approve Intent to Cut for Map 413 Lot 011.

Wallace moved; Bersaw 2nd; Board approved Building Permit for Map 412 Lot 060.

Building Permit received for Map 402 Lot 082. A member of the Board will review property and advise at Selectmen meeting on Monday, July 27, 2020.

Also discussed the results of the Public Hearing that was held on July 15 regarding a cell tower at Map 407 Lot 095. The hearing will be continued in 30 days.

Billy Hillock and Sheri Reynolds met with the Board to renew junkyard license. Wallace moved; Bersaw 2nd; Board signed 2021 junkyard license.

Road Agent Buddy Blood met with the Board to provide an update and discuss materials. Also mentioned an old car at the Town Shed that has been used for fire training. Harrington to contact Fire Chief.

Antionette Cincotta met with the Board to discuss a Public Hearing that was held on July 15th for a cell phone tower. The proper abutters were not notified. The application is now considered incomplete/incorrect and should not move forward until a revised/corrected application is received.
