Selectmen present: William Daniels, Douglas Bersaw and Andrew Wallace

Meeting opened at 5:30 pm

Wallace moved; Bersaw 2nd; the Board voted to approve the manifest dated August 5, 2019 for payroll/accounts payable in the amount of \$154,130.52 for the week of July 26, 2019-August 1, 2019. This manifest includes a payment in the amount of \$150,000.00 payable to the Monadnock Regional School District.

Bersaw moved; Daniels 2nd; Board voted to approve the sale of the trailer in the amount of \$1,500.00.

Daniels moved; Wallace 2nd; Board approved Intent to Cut for Map 412 Lot 056.

Wallace moved; Daniels 2nd; Board voted to approve Veteran's Hall rental agreement for August 17, 2019.

Harrington advised of pictures showing tire damage from Lang Road. Board reviewed.

Letter from New Hampshire Department of Transportation regarding the Richmond Highway Block Grant Aid. The anticipated amount to be available to the town of Richmond during Fiscal Year 2020 is \$58,834.81 which is an increase of \$850.92 from the Fiscal Year 2019.
