Wallace moved; Bersaw 2nd; Board voted to approve the manifest dated March 21, 2022 for week of March 11, 2022-March 17, 2022 in the amount of: \$ 157,268.40 for payroll/accounts payable. This manifest includes the monthly stipend payroll/accounts payable including the March installment of \$125,600.00 to the Monadnock Regional School District.

Daniels moved; Bersaw 2nd; Board signed MS-232. Harrington to send to New Hampshire Department of Revenue.

Daniels moved; Wallace 2nd; Board approved Supplemental Intent to Cut for Operation 21-385-10-T for Map 402 Lot 027. Owner-Hodgman.

Bersaw moved; Daniels 2nd; Board approved Demo permit for Map 408 Lot 102-141 Fitzwilliam Road. Owner-Powers.

Daniels signed application for payment from trust. Application requests to move \$15,251.63 from the Bridge Improvement Fund to replenish the General Fund. Invoice from Quantum Construction Consultants, LLC # 2990 for \$15,251.63.

Letter from Eurovia Atlantic Coast LLC requesting an updated credit application for the highway department. Daniels signed credit application.

Letter from Lisa Murphy from South West Regional Planning Commission stating the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has conditionally approved the 2021 Richmond Hazard Mitigation Plan Update. Board will need to hold public hearing to adopt the updated plan. Harrington to address questions with Lisa Murphy and let the Selectmen know at the next meeting on Monday, March 28th.

Letter from Karen O'Brien requesting the renewal of appointments for her and Suzen Perry on the Agricultural Commission which expire on March 31, 2022. Wallace moved; Bersaw 2nd; Board approved the appointments of Karen O'Brien and Suzen Perry to the Agricultural Commission. Terms to expire on March 31, 2025.

Letter from the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation regarding Local Bridge Funding Changes related to the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL). The State of New Hampshire will receive \$6,750,000.00 over 5 years totaling \$33,750,000.00. The funds are

dedicated to the rehabilitation and /or replacement of municipally owned bridges that qualify based on the NHDOT program requirements. The 5-year BIL will be administered by the NHDOT program called MOBIL (Municipally Owned Bipartisan Infrastructure Law). The state has chosen Whipple Hill Road Bridge over Roaring Brook-Br. #065/083. The MOBIL funding will need to meet Federal Aid Program. The NHDOT is in the process of programming 100% MOBIL funds into the Construction Phase of the Whipple Hill Bridge project.

Driveway Permit for Logging for Building Lot received from the New Hampshire Department of Transportation for Map 402 Lot 027-Rte 32. Owner- Hodgman. Permit to expire on 3/15/23.

Letter from Mashamee Farm, LLC members Andrew Symington and Chantal Bedard-Symington, owners of Map 402 Lot 036, regarding Map 402 Lot 032 which is currently for sale. The Symingtons' had questions for the Selectmen regarding a driveway for Map 402 Lot 032.
