Daniels moved; Wallace 2nd; the Board voted to approve the manifest dated October 5, 2020 for payroll/accounts payable in the amount of \$ 216,147.20 for the week of September 25, 2020-October 1, 2020. This amount includes a payment in the amount of \$38,491.47 payable to Quantum Construction Consultants for the bridge replacement on Whipple Hill Road and Tully Brook Road and a payment in the amount of \$165,920.36 to All States Asphalt, Inc. for the Morgan Road Upgrade.
