The inventory of equipment was covered. Projects discussed were the  
Spring cleanup, Bob will address the wall at South Cem. and Aldrich.  
Jerry M. and Bob G. will address the Nelson grave area. Jerry Mills will  
call N. Washburn again to discuss the MidTown Cem. tree work.  
Jerry M. will spread loan in the South Cem. asap. Flags are available, their  
costs are \$295 this year. Jerry M. and other members will put them out by  
May 4<sup>th</sup>. There are 3 funerals scheduled so far this year, Bowers-Bond,  
Swanson, and Herman, all at South Cem. We will be contacting B. Daniels  
regarding the use of his water buffalo for South Cem. Hugh V. is stepping  
down as Sexton. Bob G. to get batteries/paperwork, etc. from Hugh.  
Cement is needed to fix the directories at the South Cem. The 2 new flag  
poles continue to look great that were installed last year. The door to the  
shed at South Cem. needs to be fixed. Jerry M. to call Hayden B. asap.  
Work on several trees to be completed by Bob and Jerry M. asap.

A motion was made to close the meeting and approved at 10:12. The next  
meeting for the RCC is May 17<sup>th</sup>.
