*****Administrators Report**

The Fitzwilliam budget committee and School Rep. are hosting a public meeting on Jan. 11, 2017 at 6:30p to discuss current school issues. Wood did mention to the Fitzwilliam Town Administrator Richmond Selectmen's interest in meeting with them and that may be discussed tonight at the Fitzwilliam BOS meeting.

Tax refund for M405 L026 in action file for approval. Wood sent the documents that R. Drew gave the Board reference the above mentioned parcel last week.

The Veteran's credit that was on a parcel where the owner has passed has been removed.

Elderly Exemptions that were denied because income was over current amounts (both to single individuals) were \$20,400 for one individual and \$26,825.88 for the other. Both are annual income amounts.

ZCO has not contacted this office reference pending building permit application.

The Town Clerk has provided this office with an up to date term expiration list. Although none are expiring there are several vacant offices the Board should review.

The Board needs to review the government buildings stair and walkway shoveling for the winter.
