January 4, 2016 Meeting

Selectmen present: Carol Jameson, Kathryn McWhirk and Christin Daugherty

Meeting opened at 5:30pm

*****Administrators Report**

Wood stated has the Road Agent had revised his 2016 budget request and updated copies were distributed.

The Town Clerk has requested copies of the questionnaire the Selectmen sent to surrounding towns, reference wage comparison.

Wood explained that she would not be available to meet Monday, Jan. 18th. She asked if the meeting could be scheduled for Tuesday, Jan. 19th at 5:30 as there is Election training in Keene in the morning she will be attending and believes at least one Board member should attend.

Wood advised that the Town Clerk emailed her about the back door being left ajar. Wood explained that in the recent past she has had to pull the door shut (door most near the food pantry).

The Town has received the suggested monthly payment to MRHS from the business office. The suggested payment per month is \$149,357.84 (an increase of \$25,983.01). This suggested payment is for January 2016 through June 2016.

Wood reviewed a discussion she had with a resident about loggers and leaving access points a mess when leaving the property. The resident asked what the policy was on the use of Class VI roads for logging. The resident was particularly concerned with Cy Taylor Road.

Wood advised the Board that the zoning violation letter sent certified/return receipt, for M414 L028, has been returned unclaimed.

*****Approve Manifest**

McWhirk moved; Daugherty 2nd; the Board voted to approve the manifest for week of Dec. 29, 2015 – Jan. 4, 2016 in the amount of: \$121,236.21 for accounts payable/payroll. This include the 2nd of 3 payments to Savings Bank of Walpole for the County bill TAN in the amount of \$108,075.00.

Jameson advised that the Town of Richmond is filed as an intervenor, reference the pipeline, as of today.

McWhirk reported that there was a good showing last week at the “little red house”.
