Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

Selectmen in attendance: Sandra Gillis, Carol Jameson and Kathy McWhirk

Selectmen met at the Vet's Hall at 5:30pm. Gillis moved; McWhirk 2nd; the Board voted to enter Non-Public session per RSA 91-A:3II(c). Roll call: Gillis (Y), Jameson (Y), McWhirk (Y). Non-Public was entered at 5:33pm. Jameson moved; Gillis 2nd; the Board voted to close the Non-Public session. Roll call: Gillis (Y), Jameson (Y), McWhirk (Y). Non-Public was closed at 6:30pm. Minutes are not sealed.

Selectmen convened at the Town Hall at 7:00pm.

Appointments:

Joe Boulay met with the Board, reference the condition of the far end of Fay Martin Road. Boulay was under the impression that the remainder of Fay Martin Road was to be graded by end of June and it remains ungraded.

Meeting:

Mail opened and reviewed.

McWhirk moved; Jameson 2nd; the Board voted to approve the 6/24-6/30/2014 payroll and payables manifest dated June 23, 2014 in the amount of \$157,177.47. This includes a payment to MRSD in the amount of \$150,071.17.

McWhirk moved; Jameson 2nd; the Board voted to appoint Daniel Tague as Town Line Perambulator; term to expire March 2015.

Jameson moved; Gillis 2nd; the Board voted to appoint Butch Morin as Representative to Southwest Regional Planning Commission; term to expire March 2015.

Gillis moved; McWhirk 2nd; the Board voted to appoint Jonathan Beal as Town Custodian; term to expire March 2015.

The Board reviewed the NH Residential Monitoring report sent by the DRA. The DRA sampled 12 records and all received a perfect score indicating that their tax cards were accurate.

The Board reviewed the pending Tax Deed report submitted by the Tax Collector.

The Board reviewed the renovation proposals for the Library. Wood to submit the overall budget status and Trust Fund balances for next week to use in making any decisions.

The Board reviewed the proposed Police Department sign. The sign can be ordered and the funds will come from the General Government budget.

The Board reviewed and approved the proposed ZUMO and KAJOCA easements for the upgrade of Fay Martin Road.

Safety Committee meeting is scheduled for Monday, July 7, 2014 at 5:30pm.

Jameson reviewed the status of Welfare/Assistance budget.

The Board discussed the situation on Whipple Hill that was brought to their attention a few weeks ago. Wood to ask the police department to drive by the area once per shift and to investigate the multiple unregistered vehicles apparently located on the property.
