Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

Selectmen in attendance: Carol Jameson, Sandra Gillis and Kathryn McWhirk

Meeting:

Mail opened and reviewed.

The Board reviewed the "template to approximate tax rate – 2014" received from the DRA in an effort to set the tax rate. The MS-4 was revised to reflect the actual revenues to date.

McWhirk moved; Gillis 2nd; the Board voted to approve the payroll/accounts payable dated Nov. 10, 2014, for period of Nov. 4-Nov. 10, 2014, in the amount of \$ 9,138.36.

McWhirk moved; Jameson 2nd; the Board voted to approve the Intent to Cut for M409 L032.

McWhirk moved; Gillis 2nd; the Board voted to approve the Report of Cut/Yield Tax for M408 L 093, 094.

McWhirk moved; Jameson 2nd; the Board voted to approve the Intent to Cut-Supplemental for M408, L093, 094.

Gillis moved; Jameson 2nd; the Board voted to sign the Scope of Work and Costs for Environmental Services Applicant Contract on behalf of Geo-Insight Inc.

The Board discussed special warrant articles, CRF/ETF funds and publishing notices and deadlines for such postings.

The Board reviewed YTD expenditures for Legal, Executive, and General Government budgets.

The Board discussed the 2014 Annual Report. Wood advised she has requested department head/commission/committee reports by January 12, 2015.

Appointments:

J. Weekes, W. O'Brien, P. Mulhall, R. Rajaniemi /Library met with the Board, reference the 2015 Library budget request. All members reviewed the request. The 2015 request is an increase of \$41.00 over the 2014 approved budget.

The Board reviewed CIP with the Library Trustees.

J. Tonweber/Supervisors of the Checklist met with the Board, reference the 2015 budget request. The 2015 request is \$488 less than the 2014 approved budget. The major reason for the decrease is fewer elections in 2015.

W. Whitham/Moderator met with the Board, reference the 2015 budget request. The 2015 request is \$1399.00 less than the 2014 approved budget. Again, the main reason for the decrease is fewer elections than 2014.
