*****Administrators Report**

Wood asked the Selectmen about the holiday next Monday. The Town Clerk is closed and the assistant can't work the morning hours. The Board decided to be CLOSED for the holiday, Oct. 11. The Selectmen's meeting will take place Oct. 12th at 9am.

*****Approve Manifest**

McWhirk moved; Jameson 2nd; the Board voted to approve the manifest dated Oct. 4, 2016 for week of Sept. 27, 2016 – Oct. 3, 2016, in the amount of: \$8,121.63 for accounts payable/payroll.

*****Selectmen**

Jameson moved; McWhirk 2nd; the Board voted to approve the Yield Tax Levy for M405 Ls28-30, 33, M402 Ls 3 & 4, M403 L026, M404 Ls 033, 036, 039, 047, 048. The report was received on Monday which is past the due date so doomage was applied.

Jameson moved; Daugherty 2nd; the Board voted to approve the Intent to Cut for M405 Ls28-30, 33, M402 Ls 3 & 4, M403 L026, M404 Ls 033, 036, 039, 047, 048 with the stipulation that cutting does not begin until Nov. 1st per the request from the Road Agent..

McWhirk moved; Jameson 2nd; the Board voted to approve the demolition permit for the removal of the barn on M405 L121.

The Board reviewed the Deed without Covenants for the 2 parcels recently sold (M408 L068 and M414 L001). Deeds were signed and notarized. Wood will send the deeds to be recorded once the Town receives payment in full.

Contract from Avitar Associates of NE for the Town Wide update reviewed and executed.

Daugherty moved; McWhirk 2nd; the Board approved the Intent to Cut for M408 L094.

Email from Lisa Meffert from DRED, reference Town Road/Property use by Little Monadnock Family Trails ATV & Snowmobile Club – read.

Email from the Tax Collector, reference property owner’s concern over property descriptions – read.

Workshop opportunities – reviewed.

Board discussed Annual Report and upcoming budget schedule. Department heads will begin presenting their budget requests on November 7th.

Public Appointments

Liz O’Brien met with the Board, reference speed and speed signs on Whipple Hill Rd. Daugherty reviewed the activity reported by the police chief. O’Brien stated she has evidence of speed and will share that with the Chief. O’Brien also inquired about a “bus stop” sign or “slow” sign at Barrus Rd. Daugherty will discuss with the Road Agent.

Dan Earley met with the Board, reference the delayed Report of Cut for operation 15-385-18-T and the subsequent Intent to Cut on the same lots. Early would like to start as soon as possible and is willing to work with the Road Agent

Bill Coll met with the Board, reference the Quaker Cemetery and recommendation from the Worcester chapter of the Friends. Coll recommends going forward with the acquisition of the Quaker Cemetery.

Coll also discussed the land surrounding the Earl Howard cemetery. He has heard that the Conservation Commission has been discussing acquiring that land and his concern is future expansion of the cemetery. He asked the Board that if they put the land into conservation that they reserve a portion for future expansion of Earl Howard.
