Minutes: Minutes of the June 28, 2022 meeting were accepted as written.

Town Beach: Jennifer Duda reported that more town beach permits will need to be ordered as the number is running low. She will check with Town Hall about who is responsible. The NH Division of Public Health is resuming testing of public water, so they will be utilized for future testing as they are cheaper than the private company currently used.

Pavilion: Vocational students will be able to create a new sign this fall. Font and color need to be selected.

Beach Party: Details of the upcoming Beach Party were discussed. The event will be held on Saturday, July 30 (with July 31 rain date) from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. It will include beach games, prizes, pizza. It will be advertised at public event boards and at the Four Corners.

Library's Back to School event on August 13: Budgeted funds will be used to purchase backpacks and other school supplies that will be handed out to students at the event. Outdoor games will be made available. It was suggested to contact Staples to see if they can donate any school supplies.

Harvest Festival: Possible dates and activities were discussed for a harvest festival. Suggestions included pumpkins, soup, chili, vegetarian stew.

Event Notifications: Group discussed how to best contact residents regarding future events. A bulk mailing was suggested to allow residents to provide email address to receive notices of events. Another possibility was requesting event attendees to provide contact information.
