Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

Attending: Sandra Gillis and Carol Jameson

Appointments:

John Janicki met with the Board, reference Emergency Management and perhaps joining the Emergency Management team. He reviewed his experience with the Board. Janicki has vast experience with Emergency Management programs at other nuclear facilities.

CIP Committee (Wes Vaughn and Gerry Lutz) met with the Board reference the 2014 budget season. Gillis reviewed the process and new budget form. Department Heads will present both their budget request and CIP request to the Board during their scheduled meeting. CIP members may want to be at those meetings for review. Gillis explained that CIP allows the Town to plan for large equipment purchases and projects. This allows the Town to save towards these purchases. CIP helps the Town recognize if new Capital Reserve Funds need to be created. Lutz questioned the number of members to the CIP and who appoints them. Gillis stated the Board would review the original Warrant Article.

Cookie Nelson met with the Board, reference Sprague Road. Nelson stated that the road is all washed out and trees are falling. She wanted to point out the issues and go on record with those issues.

Ed Atkins/Fire Chief met with the Board. Atkins advised on the progress to the truck at Dingee. He also stated that the department is holding an open house on the 5th of October at noon. Atkins would like the BOS and Trustees of the Trust Funds to attend if possible. Atkins reviewed a Vermont Yankee Decommission meeting he attended this evening. Gillis asked for a recommendation for a representative from the FD for the Safety Committee.

Steve Boscarino/Tax Collector met with the Board reference a resident's default on their tax payment plan. This plan was put in place to avoid the tax deed process. Boscarino also advised on status of Fusco property that the Town took for Tax Deed and the prior owner is interested in purchasing back.

Meeting:

Jameson moved; Gillis 2nd; the Board voted to approve the Manifest dated Sept. 16th in the amount of \$9,718.75.

Gillis moved; Jameson 2nd; the Board voted to approve building permit number 2013-014 for M412 L011 for a lean-to.

Gillis moved; Jameson 2nd; the Board voted to notify Mr. Fusco that he may repurchase his tax deeded dwelling located on Scott Mountain Rd., M409 L052, for back taxes, interest, costs and penalties totaling \$6,911.00. Given the circumstances of this case, the BOS to wave the majority of the 15% penalty, all except the amount of 1.5%.

There being no other business, the Board adjourned at 9:10pm.
